MINUTES February 05, 2020 Jackson, Mississippi

The Mississippi Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers & Surveyors held its meeting on February 05, 2020 at the Board's office in Jackson, Mississippi.

The purpose of the meeting was to act on applications, to review correspondence, to adopt the Minutes of the recent Board meetings, to attend to old and new business and to perform student outreach.

I ANNOUNCEMENTS AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Introduction of Guests

The Board introduced itself to newly assigned legal counsel, Ken Walley, Special Assistant Attorney General and recognized David Boackle who spectated the public meeting, (until the Board's Executive Session).

2. Roll Call

Board President Steve Twedt called the meeting to order at 8:30 A.M. on Wednesday February 05, 2020. Others present were Board members Richard Tolbert, Bill Mitchell, Joe E. Lauderdale, Mike Thornton, Patrick Martino, Sarah Tracy, Dr. Dennis Truax, Carey Hardin, Board Attorney Ken Walley and Executive Director Mark Humphreys.

Board Investigator Jane Phillips, Licensing Officer Barbara Mills and Receptionist Savanna Brown joined the meeting for their segments.

3. Review and Approval of Minutes – December 04, 2019

The Board reviewed the minutes of the December 04, 2019 meeting. On a motion from Lauderdale (Joe E.) and seconded by Mitchell, the minutes were approved. 9-0 AYE. Truax, Tracy, Twedt, Tolbert, Lauderdale (Joe E.), Martino, Thornton, Mitchell and Hardin. Motion Passed.

II EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

1. Licensee Services and Outreach

A. Website

Humphreys stated that he was in contact with Ty Carr of MSI who confirmed that the expanded web template(s) in Magnolia are now available for use. Training will begin soon with the Staff Officer being primary on the website project and the Executive Director being secondary.

2. Electronic Records Management

A. CPC Database

The NCEES CPC attestation button was used by approximately 900 licensees. Humphreys reminded the Board that this was a temporary feature, as he and McManus were working on developing the ability for the licensee to upload their NCEES record into our database.

3. Training

The recommended Leadership Training course with CLEAR for the Executive Director will be at Seattle, Washington in September. Humphreys requested that the Board approve his attendance, fees and travel expenses. On a motion from Tolbert and seconded by Truax, the travel, fees and attendance was approved. 9-0 AYE. Truax, Tracy, Twedt, Tolbert, Lauderdale (Joe E.), Martino, Thornton, Mitchell and Hardin. Motion Passed.

4. PE Review Guide

The Board requested that the guide be re-titled as Board Member PE Review Guide to avoid confusion and redistributed for their review and feedback.

5. Misc.

- **A.** It was reported that the inquiry concerning "aerial photography & 3D imaging" had been answered by providing its recent Declaratory Opinion on the Practice of Surveying, so this tasked is completed.
- **B.** Letter to the Pontotoc Board of Supervisors concerning expired license of their County Surveyor.

The Board's prior Legal Counsel (Luke) and Executive Director authored and sent the letter – task completed

C. Bidding of Services and Violation of IBC – Engineers and Architects

Member Hardin reviewed the draft and offered minor changes. Those changes were incorporated into the final version and will be sent out - task complete.

6. Staff Officer

The Executive Director reported that he had reviewed all the applications and conducted interviews. Through those interviews, several strong candidates emerged and that he wanted to ensure that he still had the Board's authorization to go out of compliance to offer the position at a wage above the listed starting wage. The Board reaffirmed its approval.

The Board instructed its Executive Director to ask Harold Pizzetta if he may be available to give a presentation to MES concerning the Tire Engineers case and also requested that a few staff members be present at the Convention Center for a few hours the morning of February 27th.

IV DISCIPLINARY/LEGAL MATTERS

The Board reviewed and discussed the status of cases in progress. Ms. Phillips, Mr. Humphreys, Mr. Walley and the assigned Board Member updated the Board concerning the issues.

Motion was made by Truax and seconded by Hardin to have a closed determination to consider whether to go into executive session to discuss the Board's Disciplinary and Legal matters.

The motion received the positive vote of every member present.

The President closed the general session and opened the closed session. Motion was made by Tracy and seconded by Lauderdale to go into executive session to discuss the Board's Disciplinary and Legal matters.

The motion received the positive vote of every member present.

The President ended the closed determination and announced in general session that the Board had voted unanimously to go into executive session to discuss Disciplinary and Legal matters.

The President closed the general session and the Board entered executive session.

Motion was made by Tracy and seconded by Tolbert to end the executive session and return to general session.

The motion received the positive vote of every member present.

The President reconvened the general session and announced that the following determinations were made:

1. Case number 0515/017

Referred to AG office. In process. The Board reviewed information obtained by former Board Member Byrd. The current company literature appears to show efforts to be closer in compliance with laws and rules. Tolbert and Bobo will review, discuss and provide further updates.

2. TAB Maps Case number - N/A

Referred to AG office. At its August 7, 2019 meeting, the Board agreed with the AG Bobo's recommendation to wait until the case number 0515/017 court case was completed. No further updates.

3. Status of Cases

Investigator Phillips, Executive Director Humphreys, Attorney Walley and the assigned Board Member provided summaries on the following:

A. Case number 0219/19 – Standards Violation

Board order signed/fine paid, submitted his 3 surveys for Member Tolbert's review and approval.

New complaint on Standards Violation. Notify Mr. Barton to correct the deficiencies. All issues resolved/closed

B. Case number N/A

Informed firm to change the language on website to reflect that they are not performing engineering services in Mississippi.

Dr. Truax provided the revisions for website. Notified the Firm to make the revisions within 90 days of date of letter of notification.

Firm communicated they had decided to complete CoA process; then took their website down. Investigator Phillips is currently monitoring website; and/or awaiting a CoA application.

C. Case number 0719/01

Member Hardin reported that this case was still in process and that he would conduct interviews as soon as possible.

D. Case number 0819/02

Possible building code violation. Member Tracy reviewed and reported the case was resolved and closed.

E. Case number 0919/03

Possible faulty design specs. Member Lauderdale reported that he has reviewed all available documentation; had visited the site, and been in contact with both the complainant and licensee.

Complaint dismissed and Letter of Education issued to licensee.

F. Case number 1119/06

Working with the expired PS license. Issue an agreed order. \$1,200.00 fine, submit a re-licensure application within 30 days of execution of order and cease and desist until licensed according to our requirements.

Fine was paid, consent order signed, but incomplete re-licensure application was received and late. This portion of the complaint closed. However the Board also ordered another fine be issued for the applicant swearing into county office knowing to be an expired as a licensee who required re-licensure.

G. Case number 0919/04

Negligence. Issue formal complaint and consent order of Revocation of license. The Board determined that a hearing would be set for March 30th, 2020 as licensee had not responded to the consent order.

H. Case number 0919/05

Negligence – Issue formal complaint and consent order. \$750.00 fine, and to correct all elevation certificate surveys; and review the remaining certificates for accuracy. No fine payment received and licensee doesn't wish to sign consent order. The Board determined that they would issue a hearing to be set for March 30th, 2020.

I. Case number 1219/10

Unlicensed practice – In process. Per Member Twedt recommendation, issue a formal complaint of unlicensed practice, and proposed consent order and \$3,000.00 fine.

J. Case number 1219/09

Unlicensed practice – in process. Per Member Twedt - Issue a formal complaint of unlicensed practice, proposed consent order and \$3,000.00 fine

K. Case number 1219/08

Unlicensed practice, aiding and abetting unlicensed practice – in process. Per Member Twedt - Issue a formal complaint of unlicensed practice, proposed consent order and \$3,000.00 fine.

L. Case number 1119/07

In process. Per Member Truax, contact the complainant and request additional documentation.

The Board reviewed the data and noted that the MS results were significantly lower than the national average.

2. Old Business

A. Rules Revisions - decoupling PE exam

The Executive Director reported that the recommended language had been posted on NCEES for direct registration of the PE exam (only). Additionally the Board's website and instructions had been updated for PE initial license.

B. ICOR – New Member Orientation, February 12 – 14, 2020 in Washington DC

The Board approved its members who qualified for ICOR funding to attend. Martino & Thornton have registered.

C. Plumbing Engineering ME option.

Information for the Board, no request(s) of our Board; nor action required at this time.

D. Resolution of Cooperation

Again as decided at the October Board Meeting, the Board will await a final document and monitor the other jurisdictions feedback. Final version expected by NCEES Mega-Zone meeting in April.

3. New Business

A. 10 Year Rule question

Member Tracey asked the Board if someone lapsed their license during the 10 years of licensure; once active licensure was reconstituted did the 10 years

restart at that point, or was it accumulated from the actual point of initial licensure (minus the non-licensed timeframe). The Board re-affirmed that the ten years would be credited as the total time of "actual" active licensure.

B. Statement of Economic Interest

Humphreys reminded the Board Members that we all had until May 2020 to file or re-file their SEI.

C. NCEES – Upcoming changes to future exams

Information from Tim Miller, Director of NCEES Examination Services giving notice of future exam changes to NCEES Exams and Supporting Materials

D. Comparison of NCEES Model Laws and Rules to MS PEPLS

At the request of the Board President, the Executive Director confirmed with NCEES that they do not offer a comparison service and reported that this would be our responsibility.

F. Electronic Signatures on Certificates

Member Mitchell requested that staff continue to explore the ability to apply a quality electronic signature on licensee certificates.

Humphreys reminded that this was an article that Tolbert had also volunteered to write for a future newsletter and offered to help in that endeavor.

H. Possible Board Member Training – Afternoon of March 31

If possible after the hearing(s) that may be scheduled for March 31, Member Mitchell mentioned possible training on applications, licensure and processes. Humphreys requested additional information from the Board in order to make necessary preparations targeting the specific areas they desired.
