Subject: Construction Management Services

The Mississippi Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Surveyors and the Mississippi State Board of Architecture formed the Joint Committee on Building Design and Construction in 2013. The Committee, with members from each board, has met numerous times to discuss issues of mutual interest and shared responsibilities. Through the Joint Committee, we are committed to working together to safeguard life, health and property within Mississippi.

Recently, both Boards have discussed the topic of construction management within the scope of our licensed professionals' practice and have agreed to issue the following joint position:

An Architect or Professional Engineer, if properly qualified by training, education and experience, may perform construction management services without obtaining any additional license or certification, provided that the architect or professional engineer does not perform any construction work on the project being managed.

Additionally, a landscape architect, if properly qualified by training, education and experience, may perform construction management services for a landscape architectural project without obtaining any additional license or certification, provided that the landscape architect does not perform any construction work on the project being managed.
