Disciplinary/Legal Actions.

The Board office receives and processes complaints regarding engineering and surveying activities. Some investigations result in disciplinary actions while others result in administrative actions such as letters of education or closing unsubstantiated/insufficient complaints. Below is a recap of disciplinary actions that occurred from January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022.

Case# 1119/07, agreed to consent order for Standards of Practice violation. Monetery fine and investigative cost paid.

Case# 0721/24, Letter of explanation issued.

Case # 0122/26, agreed to a consent order for CPC violation. A monetary fine was levied and ordered to successfully complete the deficient PDHs.

Case # **0122/27**, agreed to a consent order for CPC violation. A monetary fine was levied and ordered to successfully complete the deficient PDHs.

Case# 0222/30, Closed. No action taken.

Case# 0222/31, agreed to a consent order for CPC violation. A monetary fine was levied and ordered to successfully complete the deficient PDHs.

Case# 0322/32, agreed to a consent order for CPC violation. A monetary fine was levied and ordered to successfully complete the deficient PDHs.

Case# 0522/33, agreed to a consent order for CPC violation. A monetary fine was levied and ordered to successfully complete the deficient PDHs.

Case # 1022/31, Closed. Fine assessed. Licensee requested to voluntarily surrender license and remove set pins. Must comply by December 31, 2022, or license to be revoked.
