The Fundamentals of Surveying (FS) exam is generally your first step in the process to becoming a licensed professional surveyor (P.S.). It is designed for recent graduates and students who are close to finishing an undergraduate surveying degree from an ABET-accredited program. The FS exam is a computer-based exam administered year-round in testing windows at NCEES-approved Pearson VUE test centers. The FS exam includes 110 questions, and the exam appointment time is 6 hours long. A \$225 exam fee is payable directly to NCEES.

The PS exam tests your ability to practice within the surveying profession competently. It is designed for surveyors who have gained at least four years of professional experience. The PS exam is administered year-round via computer-based testing (CBT) at approved Pearson VUE test centers. A \$375 exam fee is payable directly to NCEES.

The two-hour Mississippi PS examination is CLOSED BOOK. It consists of 100 multiple choice questions counting one point each. In Mississippi, applicants must have passed the Fundamentals of Surveying examination, the Principles & Practice of Surveying examination, and the Mississippi Section examination to be licensed as a Professional Surveyor.
